Dear Director Marootian,

We are writing to you as parents and caregivers whose children attend DC schools including Capitol Hill Montessori @ Logan, J.O. Wilson, Ludlow Taylor, Two Rivers, Mundo Verde, Maury, Peabody, and Wilson High School because too many of the streets our kids walk and ride on are unsafe. This was all too evident with the tragic death of Malik Habib on 3rd and H Street, NE in June 2018.

We are writing to urge more safety measures for us and our children as we ride our bicycles to and from school and in and around our neighborhoods. Specifically, we are writing today to support a protected bicycle lane connecting NE and NW on K St NE. K Street is the only east-west connection that crosses North Capitol Street and is a very important through-route for us, allowing us to connect to bike lanes on 4th and 6th Streets, NE and the Metropolitan Branch Trail to get between school, home, and work. We believe that the K Street NE road diet with an included bicycle lane will help accomplish important goals to provide safe passage for families between NE and NW, reduce vehicle speeds, encourage walking and bicycling, and improve quality of life for our neighborhood.

For safety reasons, it is critical that this project is intuitive for children to ride on, protected from aggressive driver behavior and car doors, and connected to a network of bicycle lanes that will allow our families to access future bicycle infrastructure on Maryland Avenue and Bladensberg Rd, so that our families can access everything from the green space at the National Arboretum to educational events at the Convention Center in Chinatown. After school and on weekends, we currently are unable to ride our bicycles with our kids from our neighborhoods in Trinidad, H St NE and Hill East to Chinatown and Shaw to the West or the Arboretum to the North/East.

As parents, we want our kids to be safe, we want the kids at our school to have fewer asthma attacks, and we want faster action on the climate crisis. We, the undersigned, urge you to move forward with the "road diet" project and add a protected bicycle lane on K St NE all the way to the Starburst to the East and Chinatown to the West. We want our kids to be protected by the decisions made by our city government, not further endangered.
